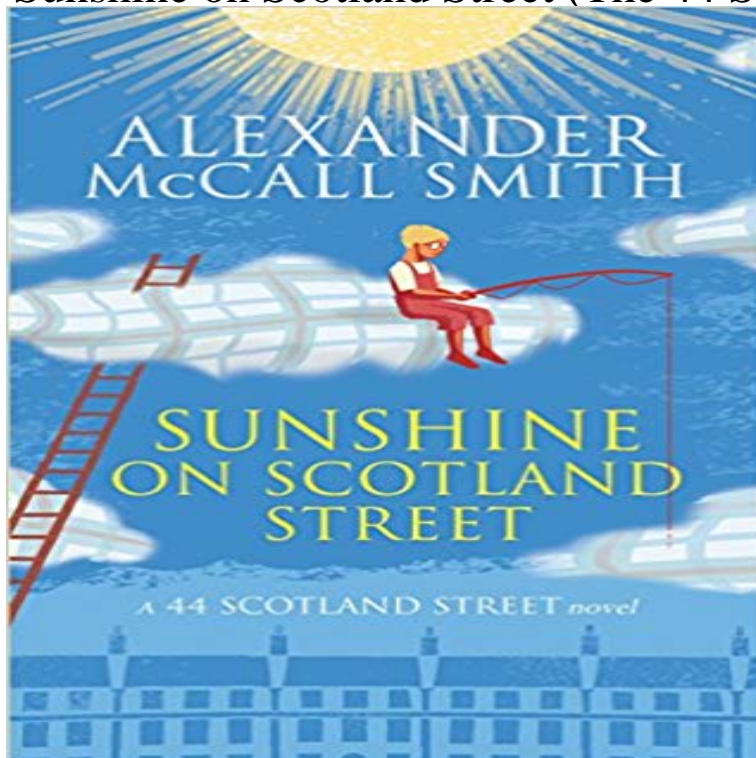


## Sunshine on Scotland Street (The 44 Scotland Street Series)
