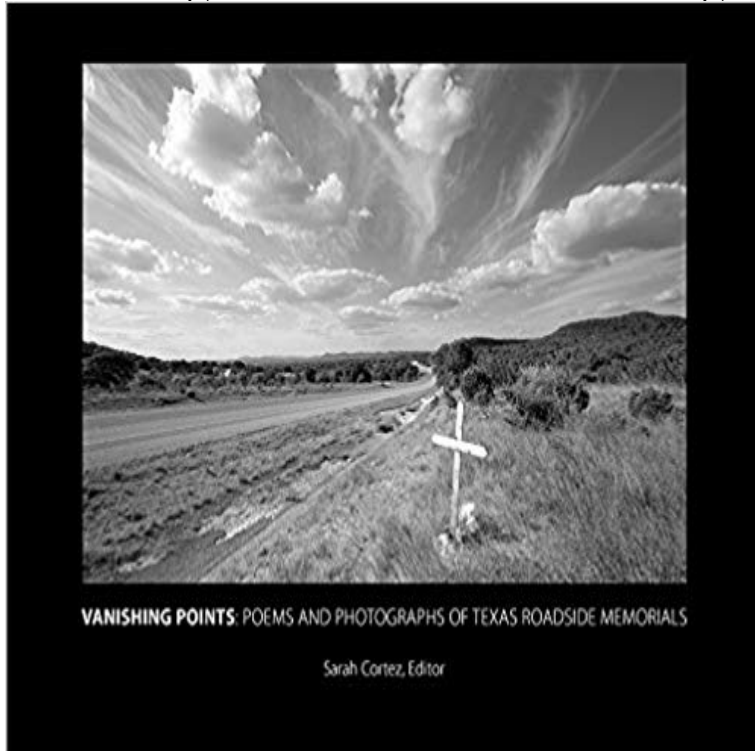


Vanishing Points: Poems and Photographs of Texas Roadside Memorials
