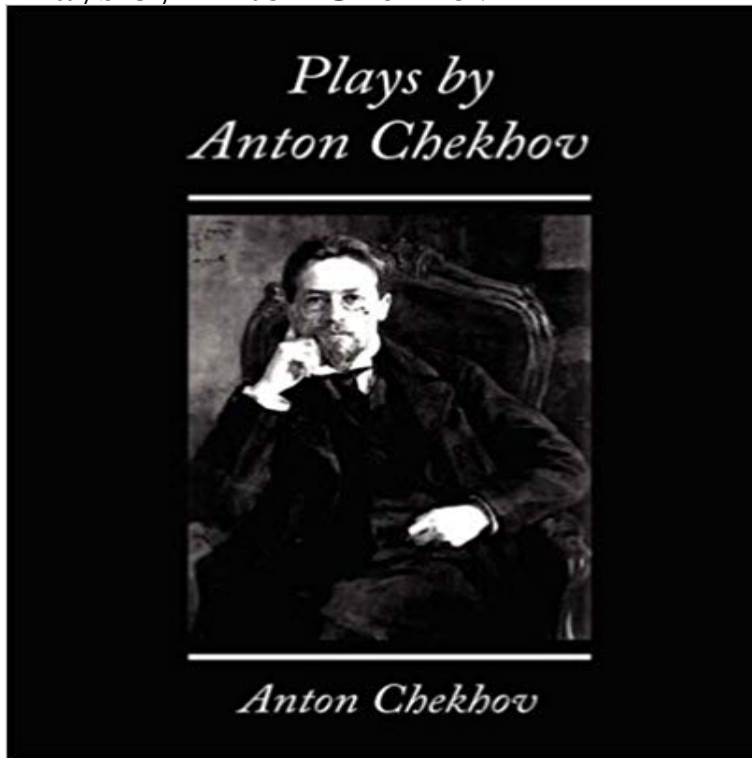


Plays by Anton Chekhov
