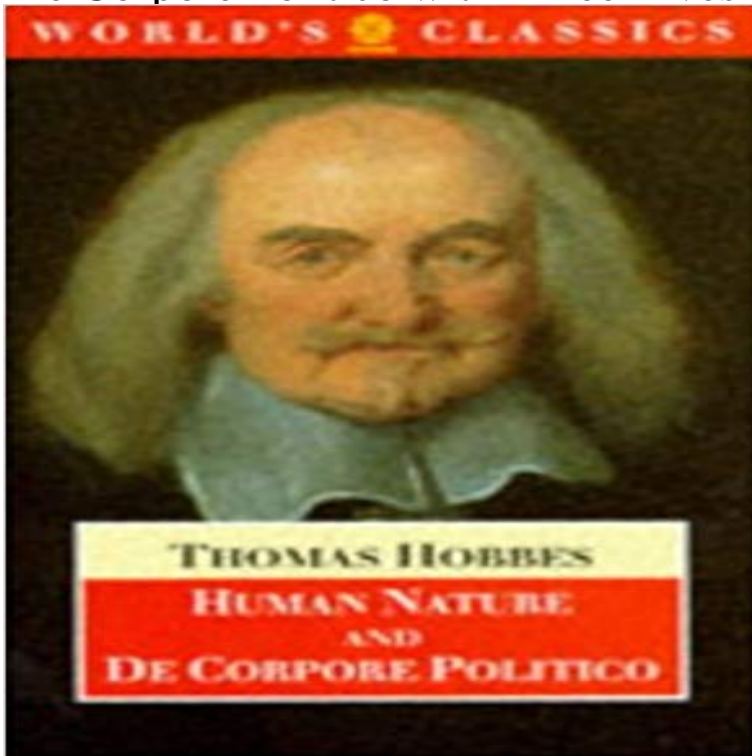


The Elements of Law, Natural and Politic: Part I: Human Nature; Part II: De Corpore Politico with Three Lives (The Worlds Classics)
